

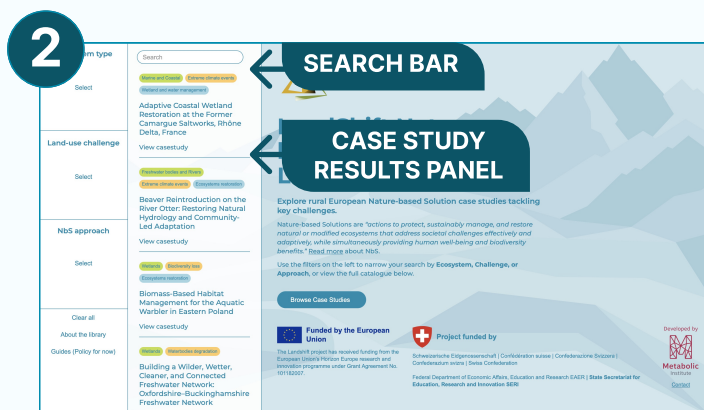
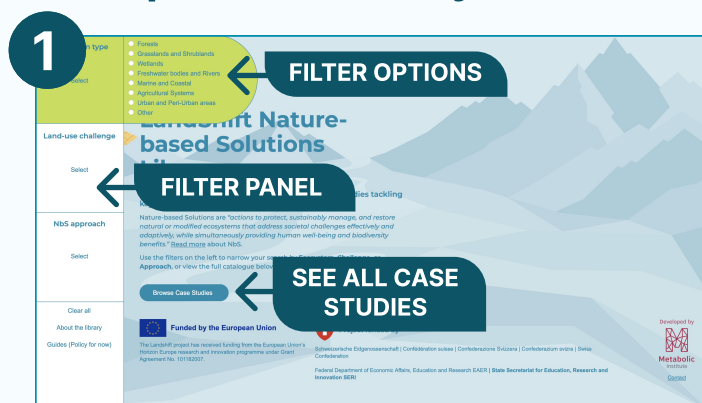
# User Guide:

## Apply filters using the left-hand panel

Filters allow you to navigate the case studies within the library by Ecosystem Type, Land-Use Challenge, and NbS Approach. You can apply any combination of these, from a single filter category or all three together by clicking to select individual options.

## Browse without filters

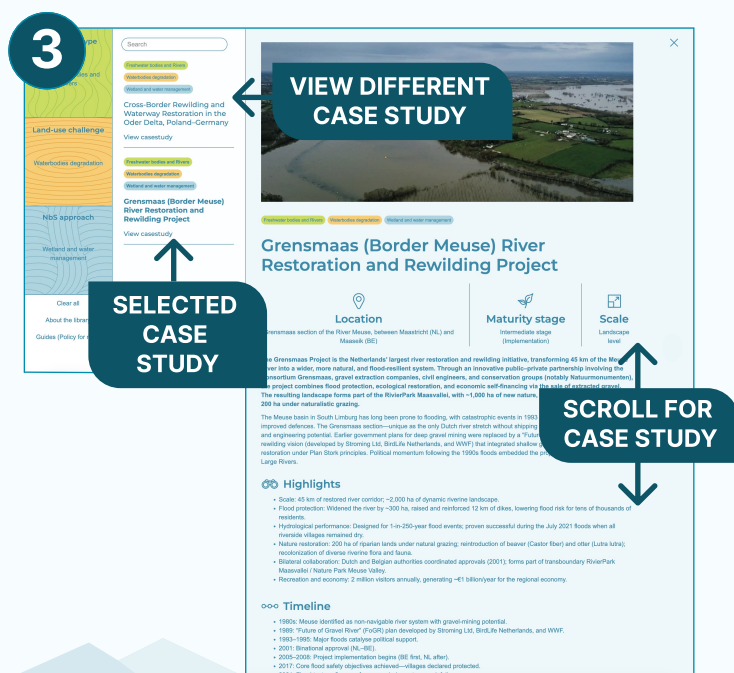
If you do not wish to apply filters, click the 'Browse Case Studies' button to see all case studies available in the library.

Once you have applied filters or clicked the "Browse Case Studies" button, the case study results panel will reveal itself, showcasing all relevant case studies.

## Use the search bar

The search bar at the top of the case study results panel lets you further refine your search by typing keywords for specific projects.

The search bar can be used in combination with the filters to help refine your results.



## Navigate between case studies without losing your place

When you click a case study, your filters and search terms remain active. This makes it easy to move between different case studies that match the same criteria.

## Access detailed information

Once you have clicked a case study to open it you will see the full details.

Each case study provides clear information about the NbS intervention, along with links to high-quality sources for deeper reading and guidance on related topics. Scroll the page to see all content.
